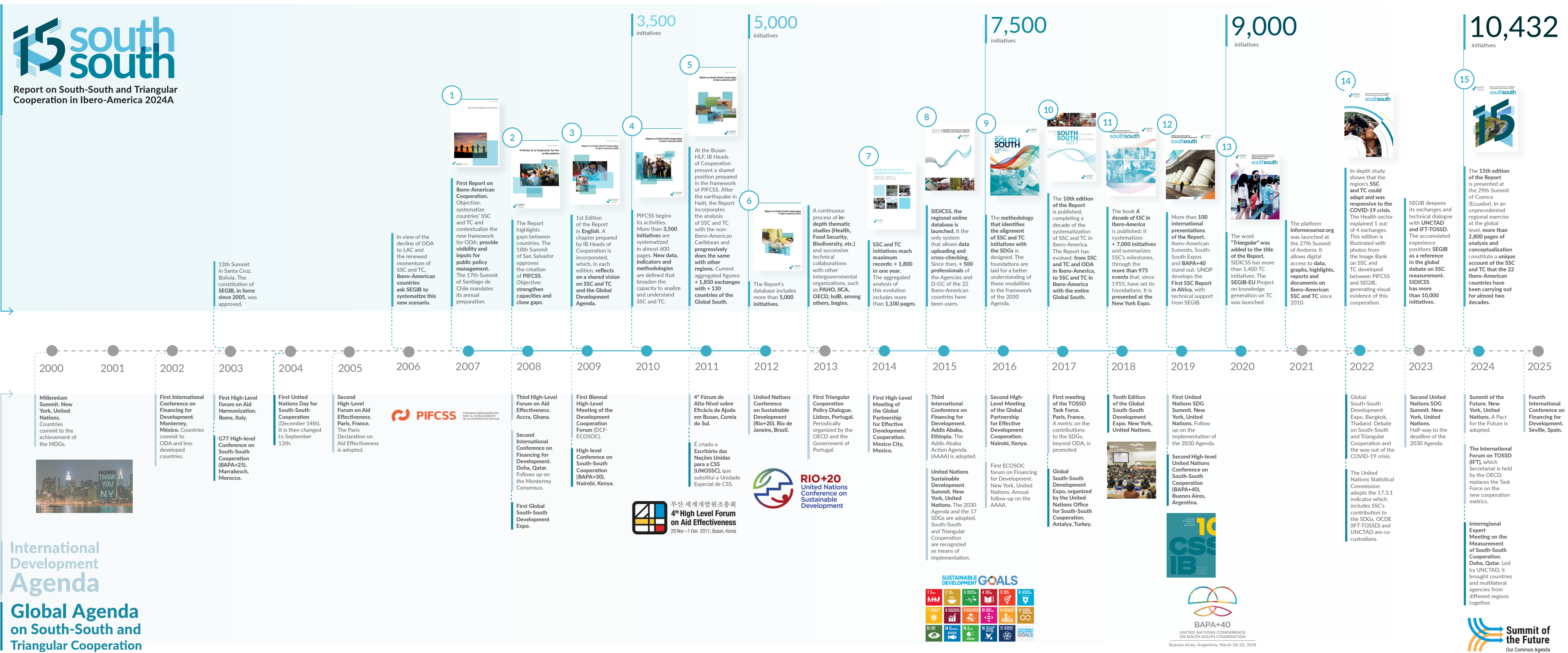

This commemorative fold-out document provides an opportunity to review the history that this Report has contributed to shape over the years while progressively gaining space and positioning as an international reference on the subject. This is a success story founded not only on the technical quality and methodological thoroughness that characterizes it, but also on the legitimacy conferred by the political commitment and the collective action taken by the countries of this Ibero-American multilateral space, which has been sustained over time.

The history of this Report should also be understood in terms of its ongoing interaction and dialogue with the regional and global agenda on development cooperation. For this reason, this infographic presents a timeline, from 2000 to 2025, which summarizes 25 years between two milestones of the International Development Agenda: the Millennium Summit in New York and the Fourth Conference on Financing for Development, scheduled to be held in Seville (Spain). This chronology highlights the origin of the Report, its evolution and main achievements (in the upper part of the infographic) while visibly connecting this information with the global development and SSTC agendas, both illustrated through the most relevant events of this first quarter century (lower part).
